Episode Theme: Being God's Workmanship

1. [Psalm 139:14](#) says, “. . . and I praise you because of the wonderful way you created me. Everything you do is marvelous! Of this I have no doubt.” How are you made in God's image? What does this tell you about how valuable you are?

2. God knows you! And not just your name, but he knows absolutely everything about you. Isn't that an amazing thought? [Psalm 139](#) tells about all the little ways that God knows you. He knows when you are resting and working. He knows when you are playing and when you're eating. He knows when you leave and when you come home. He even knows your thoughts before you think them! God knows and cares about all the parts of your life and your coming and going. If he cares so much about you and your every moment of every day, then how much more will he care about the big stuff? It's amazing and wonderful to think that God is always with us. Think about how God knows you better than anyone else ever will as you listen to this episode.

After You Listen

Knowing this and believing and embracing it as the truth is where you will find your self-worth. And this self-worth is something that no one can take away ([1 Peter 2:9-10](#)).
